A prolonged period of under investment and little modern exploration has left tremendous opportunities for exploration and development as we have seen with the success of companies such as Tirex Resources (TXX.V). With NATO's invitation to commence "accession" talks aimed at becoming a full member of NATO, political risk is also declining rapidly.

Balkan's activity is focused on projects at two separate licence areas: one for copper in the north, and the other for nickel in the south. The Perlati Project is located near Burrel, 80 km north of the capital city of Tirana. Drilling is in progress on a property under licence to Balkan for 2 years and available for a 20-year term. The Tuc Project is located south of the Puke region, 150 km north of the capital city of Tirana and is a 4km² exploration area optioned for 2 years. Drilling is also planned at the Bitincke - Kokogllave nickel project located in southeast Albania, near Korce and at the Librazhd Project a 220km² prospecting area which includes 10 former producing mines where drilling programmes are to be implemented.
